

RING 1 IN HAND SHOWING START 9.30am

- 1 **In Hand Yearlings / Youngstock** open to any type of exhibit. Yearling, 2 or 3 years old. To be shown by competent adults. Entire entrants (Colts/stallions) are welcome.
Please read the Club rules. **Entire exhibits should be marked with yellow tail ribbon.**
- 2 **In Hand Mountain and Moorland Small and Large Breeds** (May be split Small/Large if sufficient entries). *This is a TFSS Qualifier; highest placed pony aged 4 years & older will qualify.*
- 3 **In Hand Plaited Pony / Horse** Any age / height. This class is open to any exhibit with a plaited horse or pony. This class may be split if there are sufficient entries.
- 4 **In Hand Veteran** Any height / breed 15 years and over. Handlers may be any age. This class is judged in line with the VHS rules/guidance (please refer to VHS rules and regulations).
Age, conformation, manners and way of going are all considered in this class. *This Class is a TFSS Qualifier. Horses and ponies aged 15 years and over, shown with consideration for age, fitness and welfare.*
- 5 **In Hand Best Condition** Any age / height / breed. This class is open to any competitor, and is judged on the condition of horse for its type.
- 6 **In Hand Cob** Any age / height. Hogged or Hairy *This is a TFSS Qualifier. Open to horses and ponies of all cob types. Traditional and Non-traditional Cobs shown in accordance with their type.*
- 7 **In Hand Coloured**
Equifest Qualifier In Hand Piebald / Skewbald open in hand piebald / skewbald stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding any age.
TFSS Qualifier Open to all coloured horses and ponies.
- 8 **In Hand Arab / PBA / Anglo**
- 9 **In Hand Hunter / ROR / Sport horse**
- 10 **In Hand Foreign / Rare Breeds**

EQUIFEST OPEN SHOW PONY - LEAD REIN Lead rein pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 8th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle. Lead rein to be attached to the noseband only.

EQUIFEST OPEN SHOW HUNTER PONY - LEAD REIN Show Hunter Pony Lead Rein, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

13 First Ridden Show Pony / SHP. To be shown plaited 128 cms show pony / 123 cms SHP.

EQUIFEST OPEN SHOW PONY - FIRST RIDDEN First Ridden Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years and over, Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday Before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in any suitable bridle.

14 Lead Rein Mountain & Moorland. To be shown in natural state

EQUIFEST OPEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND FIRST RIDDEN Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies, registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland and Welsh A or B. Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be led by an attendant and shown in snaffle bridle, the lead rein to be attached to the noseband only.

15 First Ridden Mountain and Moorland. To be shown in natural state

EQUIFEST OPEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND FIRST RIDDEN Open to mountain & Moorland ponies, registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland and Welsh A & B. Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in any suitable bridle.

- 23 New Combination of Rider/Horse or Pony 2026.** Open to any new combination having first show season 2026. Any height horse/pony. No canter on go around but canter is optional in individual show, any suitable bridle. Lead reins welcome.

- 25 Open Novice Showing Non-native.** To be shown in a snaffle. Open to 4,5,6,7 years pony/horse and new combination of horse and rider.
- 26 Junior Equitation.** Snaffle bridles only. Rider under 18 on 1st January if the current year.

- 28 Style and Performance Walk and Trot.** To be shown in snaffle, Open to Lead Reins / First Ridden (Suitable for novice/nervous riders & horses/ponies not confident in canter).
- 29 Walk and Trot.** Suitable for novice/nervous riders & horses/ponies not confident in canter. First Ridden riders welcome; no Lead Reins. To be shown in snaffle.

JUNIOR RIDDEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND. Mares and geldings, 4 yrs old and over, registered in the respective pure breed stud books of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland and Welsh Section A, B, C & D. Riders of Small Breeds not to have attained their 14th birthday before 1st Jan in the current year. Riders of Large Breeds not to have attained their 18th birthday before 1st Jan in the current year.

- 31 Ridden coloured Plaited.**
EQUIFEST RIDDEN PIEBALD /SKEWBALD (Spotted, Roan & Palomino not eligible for Equifest qualifier). Open ridden Piebald / Skewbald stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over. Riders of any age.
- 32 Show Hunter Pony 153cms & Under and Show Hunter Horse exceeding 153cms.**
EQUIFEST OPEN RIDDEN SHOW HUNTER PONIES. Show Hunter Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 153cms. Any suitable sized rider. Classes may be divided as follows: Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 123cms; Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 133cms but not exceeding 143cms; Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 143cms but not exceeding 153cms.
EQUIFEST YOUNG RIDERS. Mare or gelding exceeding 153cms but not exceeding 158cm; rider not to have attained their 25th birthday before the 1st of January in the current year.
EQUIFEST OPEN RIDDEN HUNTERS. Open Ridden Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 158cms. Riders of any age.
- 33 Sports Horse / R.O.R / Foreign Breeds.**
Equifest Open Re-trained Racehorse. Thoroughbred mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, any height. Horses must have been raced in the GB to be eligible to compete.

34 Pure and Part Bred Arab/ Part Bred Welsh. For qualifiers horse must be registered with the Arab Horse Society.

EQUIFEST RIDDEN PART BREEDS. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Exhibits in this section must be registered in the Part Bred Section of their respective Breed Society. Horses and ponies will not be ridden at the final. Suitable sized rider of any age.

Classes 35 / 36 will be together if numbers are low

EQUIFEST OPEN RIDDEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND. Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland and Welsh Section A, B, C or D. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old or over. Rider any age.

35 Mountain and Moorland Large Breeds. Large Breeds - Dales, Fell, New Forest, Connemara, Highland, Welsh Section C & D. Riders of any age.

36 Mountain and Moorland Small Breeds. Small Breeds - Shetland, Welsh Section A & B, Dartmoor and Exmoor. Riders any age.

This is a TFSS Qualifier Mountain and Moorland breed shown in accordance with their breed standards.

37 Open Show Pony/Horse Mixed Height Qualifier. Mare or gelding, 4 years old or over. Exceeding 148cms but not exc 160cms. Riders any age.

EQUIFEST OPEN RIDDEN SHOW PONIES. Open Show Pony - Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over not exceeding 148cm. Any suitable sized rider. Classes may be divided as follows: Show Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cm. Show pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over exceeding 128cms but not exceeding 138cms. Show pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 138cms but not exceeding 148cms.

EQUIFEST YOUNG RIDERS. Mare or gelding exceeding 146cms but not exceeding 158cm riders not have attained their 25th Birthday before 1st of January in the current year.

EQUIFEST OPEN RIDDEN HACKS. Open show Hacks, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 160cms. Riders of any age. Classes may be divided as follows: **Small Hacks** - mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 154cms Riders of any age. **Large Riding Horse** - mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 158cms but not exc 160cms. Riders of any age.

38 Open Ridden Veteran Horse/Pony.

VHS Qualifier. 15 years old and over. Pony/horse. Open to all inc Lead Rein / First Ridden stallion, mare or gelding. Any type or breed. Riders of any age. Classes may be divided according to entries.

TFSS Qualifiers. Horses and ponies aged 15 years and over, shown with consideration for age, fitness and welfare.

39 Ridden Coloured Native/Cob/Traditional. Open to any Cobs & Cob Types, 4 years old and over. **EQUIFEST OPEN RIDDEN COBS.** Mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms. To be shown hogged and trimmed. Riders of any age. Classes may be divided as follows: Open Lightweight Ridden Cob, mare or gelding, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms. To be shown hogged and trimmed. Riders any age.

EQUIFEST OPEN MAXI COBS open to Maxi Cobs, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 155cms - to be judged as Cobs. To be shown hogged and trimmed. Riders of any age.

This Class is a TFSS Qualifier Open to horses and ponies of all cob types. Traditional and non-traditional cobs shown in **accordance with their type.**

Qualifier Association Rules and Information

***NCPA Qualifiers** 1st & 2nd Place will Qualify POYS on 13/09/2026 at warren farm EC Fornby L37 OAN.

***ESUK** This show is affiliated to Equine Sport UK (ESUK) Grassroots Championship. Taking place at Arena UK, Grantham, Lincolnshire on the 30/07/2026 to 01/08/2026. The three highest placed competitors will qualify in each class.

***EQUIFEST.** This show is affiliated to Equifest, taking place at Arena UK, Grantham Lincolnshire on the 05/08/2026 to 08/08 202. The two highest placed exhibits not already qualified in each affiliated class will qualify. No membership is required to enter these classes.

VETERAN HORSE SOCIETY - AREA QUALIFIER 2026. Open to members and non-members. All competitors and grooms must adhere to VHS Rules in all circumstances. Failure to do so may result in immediate disqualification.

VHS Regional Final qualification. All competitors placed 1st to 4th in each age category will qualify for the corresponding class at VHS Regional Finals. Members must carry their cards in the ring and have their showing card signed by the judge in the ring as proof of qualification, Non-members will receive a red qualification card which can be exchanged for a signed showing card when applying for VHS Membership. This MUST be done within 21 days of qualification. It is the competitors responsibility to present their Showing Card to the judge. Those wishing to join or renew with the Society will need to apply for this before the 1st may each year or a late penalty fee of £15 will be charged. Regional Finals are open to members only. All competitors are eligible to enter open classes at the National Veteran Championships, to be held at Arena UK Lincolnshire on 4th-6th September 2026. No qualification or membership necessary - see VHS website for schedule which is available mid-season 2026. TFSS Qualifiers

Rules, Eligibility and Qualifying Classes All classes at this show are run under The Friendly Showing Society (TFSS) Official Rulebook (v1.0, effective from 20 January 2026). By entering, all competitors confirm that they have read, understood, and agree to abide by the TFSS Rules and the conditions set out in this schedule. The TFSS Rulebook applies in full unless otherwise stated within this schedule. In all matters of welfare, safety, eligibility, and conduct, TFSS Rules take precedence.

TFSS Qualifying Classes The following classes may be offered as TFSS qualifiers, in-hand and/or ridden, where approved. Only those classes formally approved by TFSS may be run as qualifying classes at this show. Classes may include, but are not limited to: Open Cob, Open Coloured Horse or Pony, Open Riding Horse / Hack, Open Hunter, Open Mountain and Moorland, Veteran Horse or Pony. Specific class conditions will be stated in the individual class descriptions.

Qualification. 1st place qualifies; 2nd place qualifies only if 1st has already qualified. Qualifications do not automatically pass down the line. Qualification may be withheld if, in the Judge's opinion, the required standard has not been met. Qualification is horse- or pony-specific and not transferable. The Judge's decision is final. It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure that qualification cards are correctly completed, signed, and dated by the Judge, and that a clear copy of the horse or pony's passport identification page is submitted in accordance with TFSS Instructions.

TFSS accepts no responsibility for missing, incomplete, or incorrectly submitted documentation.

Horse Welfare. Horse welfare is the overriding principle at all TFSS-affiliated competitions. The Judge, Steward, or Show Officials reserve the right to: Inspect tack, bits, spurs, and equipment at any time; eliminate competitors where welfare or safety is compromised; refuse entry to, or remove, any horse or pony deemed unfit, distressed, lame, exhausted, or unsafe in the interests of safety and welfare. Any fall of horse, rider, or handler will result in immediate disqualification. The judging decisions are final.

Eligibility. Horses and ponies must be four years old or over to compete in both in-hand and ridden classes. Stallions are permitted unless otherwise stated in the schedule and must be correctly registered and handled or ridden by a competent adult. Junior competitors may not ride or handle stallions. Any additional eligibility requirements will be stated in the individual class description.

Tack and Equipment. All tack must be safe, correctly fitted, and appropriate to the class. Training aids are not permitted in the competition ring. Any tack, bit, or equipment deemed inappropriate by the Judge or Steward may be prohibited.

Judges and Stewards. All Judges officiating at TFSS qualifying classes must be members of the TFSS Approved Judges' Panel. Stewards act on behalf of TFSS and have authority to enforce the Rules in the interests of welfare and safety. All judging decisions are final.

Conduct, Behaviour and Social Media. Abuse of horses, officials, judges, stewards, volunteers, or competitors will not be tolerated. Unsporting behaviour, including defamatory, abusive, or inflammatory comments made online by competitors or their associates acting on their behalf, which are likely to bring TFSS, its officials, or its competitions into disrepute, may be treated as a breach of TFSS Rules. TFSS reserves the right to issue warnings, eliminate competitors, withdraw qualification, or refuse future participation.

Insurance and Liability. All competitors enter and compete at their own risk.

CADRC Show Rules

- 1 At all CADRC events, protective riding hats must be worn when mounted. Hats to conform to PAS015 or higher. Juniors must wear protective headwear for both mounted and unmounted classes.
- 1a Hats must be correctly adjusted and fastened.
- 2 No rider will be permitted to enter any class unless correctly dressed including hard hat, suitable footwear, jacket and light-coloured jodhpurs. (At judge's discretion based on weather conditions).
- 3 It is the responsibility of competitors to ensure they are at the ring in time for their class. If a competitor is unable to enter the ring when called, it is the responsibility of the competitor to inform the ring steward. Competitors leaving a ring when the class is in progress will only be allowed back at the discretion of the judge. Only real emergencies will be accepted as a reason for disrupting a class.
- 4 No cantering/galloping on the show ground outside of the rings – offenders will be asked to leave the showground and no refund of class fees will be made. Warm up areas are available.
- 5 Stallions/colts must be bitted at all times and handled/ridden by an adult (18yrs or over on 01.01.2026).
- 6 Riders must keep to working in areas and are not permitted in pedestrian walkways. Working in is forbidden on the parking field. Pedestrians must keep to their designated walkways. No horses or ponies are allowed in the vicinity of the Show Office.
- 7 Horse/ponies which kick **MUST** wear a red ribbon in their tail. We advise that a green or young horse wears a green ribbon in their tail.
- 8 Show entry fees will only be refunded in the event of a class being cancelled or upon receipt of medical/veterinary evidence.
- 9 The judge's decision is final.
- 10 It is the responsibility of all competitors and owners to ensure the welfare of their equine is given priority whilst on the showground; horse/ponies should not be left unattended if at all possible.
- 11 All dogs to be kept on a lead and under control at all times.
- 12 No misuse of the whip, bit, spurs or other tack will be tolerated; offenders will be asked to leave the showground with no refund given. The judge's decision or that of any CADRC Committee Member is final.
- 14 Lunging is not permitted.
- 15 All ridden horses must be 4yrs or over.
- 16 Any complaints must be taken up with the Show Secretary within 30 minutes of a class finishing, with a fee of £20. This will be returned if the complaint is upheld.
- 17 Juniors = 18yrs of age and under at 1st January in the current year; unless specified for qualifiers.
- 18 Juniors are not permitted to wear spurs in any classes.
- 19 Junior handlers must have a responsible adult on hand whilst in the ring who can take over or assist should the child get into difficulties with their pony.
- 20 CADRC committee reserve the right to alter and amend this schedule.
