All competitors must have their own personal and third party insurance and provide documentary evidence of such cover if requested to do so by the organiser.

Ring 1 – Show Jumping (classes may be split junior/senior if numbers permit)

Showjumping will run if the committee consider the ground suitable and social media will be updated prior to the show

21. Cross poles (no higher than 50cm) to include Lead rein
22. 50-55cm
23. 60-65cm
24. 70-75cm
25. 80-90cm

Notes for show jumping classes – entries into class 21 may also enter class 22 only

For classes 22-25, horse/rider combinations may enter a maximum of 3 consecutive classes.

Entries to class 22 may not enter class 24 or 25 and vice versa

Juniors are **not** permitted to wear spurs

RING 1 WILL NOT START BEFORE 12.00pm

Ring 2 – Ridden and in hand showing

Starting at 9am prompt

Class 1 In hand Youngstock – 3 years and under. Colts to be handled by adults only and bitted at all times.

Class 2 Bonny Pony/Handsome Horse In-hand – handlers 10yrs & under may be assisted by an adult (must be from same household)

Class 3 M&M In-hand – Large or small breeds – handlers 10yrs & under may be assisted by an adult (must be from same household)*

Class 4 Lead Rein Equitation Including M&M, Show Ponies, Hunter Ponies – Rider 10yrs and under (handler must be from same household), snaffle only (may also enter class 11 but no other ridden classes off the lead rein may be entered)

Class 5 In hand veteran Any breed over 15 yrs

Class 6 In hand coloured/Palomino/Dun/spotted

Class 7 Open type In-hand – Any breed/height/age

In-Hand Championship, 1st and 2nd place class winners only from classes 1-7

Class 8 Tack and Turnout

Class 9 Green Ridden horse/pony 7yrs and under- snaffle bridle

Class 10 Ridden M&M Large or small breeds*

Class 11 Junior First Ridden to trot including M&M, Show Ponies, Hunter Ponies – Rider 12yrs and under, any suitable bridle

Class 12 Junior First Ridden to Canter Rider 12yrs and under, any suitable bridle **(may not enter class 4)**

Class 13 Senior First Ridden open to anyone with confidence issues, or a young horse with no experience. Individual canter will be allowed but is not compulsory.

Class 14 Riding Club Horse/Pony - any suitable bridle, riders 10yrs & under may be shown on a lead rein. May include a small jump and you will be required to dismount and remount in the ring (mounting block will be available)

Class 15 Ridden Equitation Rider any age – snaffle bridle.

Class 16 Ridden Veteran – Any breed 15yrs and over

Class 17 Ridden Coloured/Palomino/Dun/Spotted

Class 18 Open Type Ridden

Class 19 Ridden Cob meets Ridden Hunter Any height, any colour, hogging not necessary* (2 classes combined)

Class 20 Concours D'Elegance If the rider is 12yrs and under they may be shown on a lead rein

*If classes are oversubscribed we will split and judge separately

Ridden Championship, 1st place and 2nd place class winners only from classes 8-20

Notes for Ring 1

- Any classes split Jnr/Snr apply only if class size warrants and at judge's discretion
- Green – Inexperienced/young horse or pony (7 years and under)
- No martingales permitted in ridden showing classes
- Age of rider is as of 01/01/2021
- Juniors not permitted to wear spurs **in any class**
- All classes, unless otherwise stated, may be ridden in any suitable bit
- **Stallions/colts (2 years & over) must be bitted at all times and be handled/ridden by an adult (18yrs or over at 01.01.2021)**
- Mountain & Moorland Small Breeds to include Welsh Section A & B, Exmoor, Dartmoor & Shetland Welsh Section C & D, Fell, Dales, Connemara, Highland & New Forest

CADRC Show Rules

1. At all CADRC events, protective riding hats must be worn when mounted. Juniors must wear protective headwear for both mounted and unmounted classes. according to the current standards as listed below:
 - a. All PAS 015 1998 or 2011; VG1; ASTM F1163 04a onwards; SNELL E2001; AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards
 - b. Please note that from 1st January 2017 the list no longer includes BS/EN1384 or EN1384/PAS015 without a kitemark
 - c. Hats must be correctly adjusted and fastened.
2. No rider will be permitted to enter any class unless correctly dressed including hard hat, suitable footwear, jacket and light-coloured jodhpurs.
3. It is the responsibility of competitors to ensure they are at the ring in time for their class. If a competitor is unable to enter the ring when called, it is the responsibility of the competitor to inform the ring steward. Competitors leaving a ring when the

class is in progress will only be allowed back at the discretion of the judge. Only real emergencies will be accepted as a reason for disrupting a class

4. **No cantering/ galloping** on the show ground outside of the rings – offenders will be asked to leave the showground and no refund of class fees will be made.
5. **Stallions/colts must be bitted at all times and handled/ridden by an adult (18yrs and over on 01.01.2021)**
6. Riders must keep to working in areas and are not permitted in pedestrian walkways. Working in is not permitted on the parking field. Pedestrians must keep to their designated walkways. No horses or ponies are allowed in the vicinity of the show office.
7. Horse/ponies which kick **MUST** wear a **red** ribbon in their tail. We advise that a green or young horse wears a **green** ribbon in their tail
8. Show entry fees will only be refunded in the event of a class being cancelled or upon receipt of medical/veterinary evidence.
9. You may be asked to produce your card to qualify for highest place member rosettes.
10. The judge's decision is final
11. It is the responsibility of all competitors and owners to ensure the welfare of their horse/pony is given priority at all times on the showground.
12. All dogs to be kept on a lead.
13. No misuse of the whip, bit, spurs or other tack will be tolerated, **offenders will be asked to leave the showground with no refund given.**
14. No lunging permitted.
15. All ridden horses must be 4yrs or over.
16. Any complaints must be taken up with the show secretary within 30 minutes of a class finishing, with a fee of £20. This will be returned if the complaint is upheld.
17. **Juniors = 18yrs of age and under at 1.1.2021**
18. Junior handlers must have a responsible adult on hand whilst in the ring who can take over/assist should the child get into difficulties with their pony.

Entry Fees:

MEMBERS: £7 per class or 3 classes for £20

NON MEMBERS £9 per class or 3 classes for £25

£2 contribution per rider towards first aid

Any Entries received and paid 4 days before show date will have a £1 early bird discount off each pre entered class

Rules:

Juniors are 18yrs and under as on 1/1/2021

Junior riders are not permitted to wear spurs in any classes.
